We are enclosing some information we found in our files on Englefeld.

The following is a brief historical resumé of the spelling of this name, acquired from the noted sources:

1. Regina Land Titles Office

- Railway plan - registered 1906 - Engelfeld.
- First registered plan - 1908 - Englefeldt.
- Thirteen registered plans between 1916 and 1936 - Englefeldt.
- Master of Titles Order, March 9th, 1936, cancelling the t - resulting in Englefeld.
- All registered plans after 1936 - Englefeld.

2. Provincial Archives, Regina

- School District Files - District established in 1908 - Englefeld.
- From 1909 to 1930 all School District correspondence - Englefeld.
- Postmaster General's Reports (list of accounting Post Offices in Canada) - 1907, 1908 and 1919 - Englefeld.

3. Provincial Archives, Saskatoon

- 1906 - Post Office recognized as Engelfeldt.
- 1908 - Henderson's Directory - Englefeld.
- 1916 - Published in the Saskatchewan Gazette - incorporated as the Village of Englefeld.

4. Saskatchewan Department of Municipal Affairs

- 1916 - Published in the Saskatchewan Gazette - incorporated as the Village of Englefeld.
